Order of Proceedings.

1. At 5.45 p.m. the Brethren assemble in the Lodge Room, with the exception of the Present and Past Prov. G. Officers and Visitors of distinction, who will assemble in the Ante-Room.
2. The Lodge is opened in the Three Degrees by the Worshipful Master of the Easterford Lodge, No. 2342.
3. The Provincial Grand Grand Master, accompanied by the Provincial Grand Officers, etc., will enter in procession and take the Chair.
4. The Provincial Grand Master will be saluted according to ancient form.

11. The Deputy Provincial Grand Master Designate having signified his assent will kneel and take the O.B.
12. The Provincial Grand Master will invest the Deputy Provincial Grand Master with the Collar and Jewel of his office; after which he will be placed in the chair at the right of the R.W.Prov.G.M.
