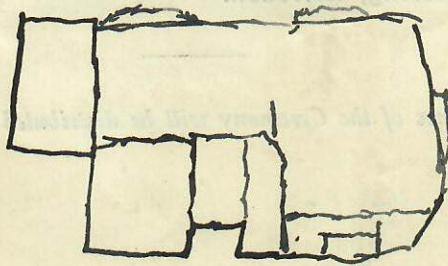
1. The Brethren will assemble at 5.30 punctually.

Procedure of the Ceremony of Dedication

1. The Brethren assemble in the Temple with the exception of the Provincial Grand Lodge Officers, who will assemble in the adjoining Room.
2. The Lodge is opened in the Three Degrees.
3. The Provincial Grand Master, accompanied by his Officers, enters the Lodge attended by Grand Lodge Officers, and having taken the Chair appoints his Officers.

4. Opening Hymn.

Hail, Eternal, by whose aid
All created things were made,
Heaven and earth Thy vast design,
Hear us, Architect Divine.

May our work, begun in Thee,
Ever blest with order be;
And may we when labours cease
Part in harmony and peace.

By Thy glorious Majesty,
By the trust we place in Thee,
By the badge and mystic sign,
Hear us, Architect Divine.

SO MOTE IT BE.

5. The Provincial Grand Master and Grand Lodge Officers are saluted severally according to antient form.
6. The Provincial Grand Master addresses the Brethren on the motive of the Meeting, and calls upon the Chaplain to give the

Opening Prayer.

7. **Chant** (*Omnes*): So mote it be.

8. The Architect will hand the plans of the completed structure to the Prov. Grand Master.
9. The Worshipful Master will request the R.W. Prov. Grand Master to fix the commemoration stone.
10. The R.W. Prov. Grand Master, accompanied by his Officers, will proceed to the entrance of the Temple for this purpose.

11. The R.W. Prov. Grand Master will call upon the Prov. Grand Secretary to read the inscription on the Stone.
12. The R.W. Prov. Grand Master will call on the Prov. Grand Treasurer to place the phial in the stone after announcing its contents.
13. The Stone will be placed in its position by the R.W. Prov. Grand Master.
14. The R.W. Prov. Grand Master and his Officers will then return to the Salter Memorial Room.
15. A Past Master of the Lodge will request the Provincial Grand Master to Dedicate the Room to Masonic Purposes.
16. The Provincial Grand Master signifies his assent and calls upon the Provincial Grand Chaplain for
17. **The Oration.**
18. **Anthem.**

Except the Lord build the house their labour is but lost that

19. **Dedication Prayer.**
20. **Chant** (*Omnes*): So mote it be.
21. *Sanctus*—GLORY BE TO THEE, O GOD.
22. All the Brethren turn towards the East, when the Provincial Grand Master gives

23. **Chant** (*Omnes*): So mote it be.
24. The Chaplain reads 2 Chronicles, chapter ii., verses 1 to 16.
25. The Lodge Board is then uncovered, and the Provincial Grand Master and Wardens carry the elements of Consecration three times round the Lodge, halting in the East at the first perambulation, at the West at the second perambulation, and in the South at the third perambulation (Solemn Music during the procession).
26. The Chaplain reads Psalm lxxii., verse 16.
